Baker's music ministry includes concert and festival performances around the world. She has shared the stage with Shirley Caesar, CeCe Winans, Fred Hammond and more.

Her recordings include *The Live Encounter*, produced by Grammy Award winner Myron Butler.

Floyd has toured and performed extensively with Ray Charles, Rusty Bryant, Jeff Tyzik, Chris Howes, Byron Stripling, Sarah Morrow and his own trio. He is also a frequent soloist with the Columbus Jazz Orchestra.

McClendon is a long-time leading light on the Columbus Jazz scene. Each a diva in her own right, the Ladies of the Lincoln is a vocal trio comprised of Janeen Holmes, La'Toya Jones, and Christina Myles, three alumni of the Lincoln's Expand Your Horizon Incubation Program.
